ANNUAL FEE CONTRIBUTIONS FOR KINDERGARTEN PLACES FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2015-16

Children entering Kindergarten should be 3 years of age by the end of May although some consideration can be made.

Where a child is eligible, the School can currently claim, on behalf of parents, the Government Nursery Funding Support for children between the age of 3 to 5 years. For this you will be required to complete & sign a form for the School to provide to the local authority. If you wish the School to claim Nursery Funding on your behalf, the reduction in fees will need to be calculated on an individual basis as the amount reclaimable is subject to variable factors including that no other claim is being made on behalf of the child elsewhere.

There are reductions for family siblings as follows: 2nd child -10%, 3rd child -25%.

Fee Contributions are payable in advance Each Term or by Standing Order monthly in advance starting 5th August until 5th July the following year.

A further small discount is available if the total annual fee contributions are paid in advance before the beginning of the academic school year.

To secure a place for your child, the following deposits are required:

£500 per child for Kindergarten plus a further £500 when the child goes up to Class 1.

£1,000 per child from Classes 1-8

Late payments will be subject to a 20% surcharge if not paid on the commitment date unless otherwise agreed in advance with the Finance Group.

Additional charges apply for:

Processing fees (*see application forms for details*), Class Outings, Trips, Recorders, Wax Crayons, Coloured Pencils

Along with any extra tuition as deemed necessary by the school and as agreed with parents.

Normally no Bursaries are provided for new children in their first year and no Bursaries, aside from sibling discounts, are provided for children in the kindergarten

Occasionally, the finishing times/days are subject to necessary change, when parents will be notified as soon as it is possible.

Additional voluntary contributions to support The School Bursary Fund

It is a fact of the Steiner educational philosophy that schools should represent the broadest range of families within society.

The School Bursary Funding is to help the families who would not otherwise be able to benefit from our education.
